



## Transition Checklist for Parents

To best prepare for the initial VR intake meeting for your son or daughter, gather the following documents. *These documents are not required but are recommended.*

- Basic info: name, current address, preferred phone number(s)
- Social Security number (original card not required)
- Names, addresses, and phone numbers of current doctors
- Names and medications and dosages currently taking
- Parent's proof of income or previous year's tax return.
- Recent IEP/ School Records
- Last psychological evaluation
- Picture ID

**Protection, Use and Release of Personal Information-** GVRA protects your privacy by keeping all information about your family member confidential.

**Information and Referral Services-** If it is determined that your son/daughter cannot benefit from VR services, the VR Division will provide information and referral to other more appropriate resources to assist you with your needs.
