Measures of accountability for schools and districts in GA

psychiatric manual used to aid in diagnosing mental disorders
student whose native language is not English and is learning English
old term, no longer currently used, see MID

Georgia High School achievement tests given at the completion of specific high school courses
Georgia Elementary and Middle School achievement tests given in grades 3 - 8 in certain subjects
regular ed services provided to students whose native language is not English
all students with a disability ages 3-21 have this right
purpose is to determine the causes behind inappropriate behaviors
data collected and sent to state department in order to obtain funding for running school system
Georgia's alternate achievement test for students with significant cognitive disabilities

Georgia's current testing program for measuring kindergarteners' achievement, first grade readiness
services for students with severe behavioral issues related to emotional problems or autism
individual number assigned to a Georgia student

Federal Law regarding education of Students with Disabilities
individual plan for educating eligible students, reviewed yearly
plan for serving eligible children ages birth-2
measure of intelligence (100=average)
representative appointed by school system & has authority to commit funds

prevention framework of evidence-based, system-wide practices to support a rapid response to academic and behavioral needs.

description of a student's current skills levels, strengths, and needs

statistical term, ex. +/- 15 points from average on bell curve

IQ ranges between 70-85

trained professional qualified to provide speech therapy to eligible students

plan for serving private school or home-school eligible students

data collected and sent to state department annually at the end of the school year

group of individuals who need to plan an intervention for a student who is struggling

old term, no longer currently used, see MOID

usually referring to a vision/hearing screening by school nurse
